In general, please register in advance by post, by e-mail or via the registration form on the homepage from the Bildungsstätte Gartenbau, mentioning the **seminar number 031/26** with your full address and your room wish. Cancellations are free of charge up to 28 days before the start of the event and must be made in writing. For cancellations made between 27 and 14 days before the start of the event, we will charge 50% of the costs for up to 15 participants and 65% of the costs for 16 or more participants. The number of participants specified by the organiser will be used as the basis for invoicing. For cancellations within 13 days before the start of the event, we charge 100% of the planned costs. If there is no specific agreement regarding the room category, the educational institution will base its calculations on a standard single room per participant. Registrations and cancellations of individual participants must always be made in writing. If a cancellation is made on the day of the event or if the registered person does not show up, 100% of the costs of the booked accommodation and meals will be charged. For cancellations within 10 days before the start of the event, we charge 50% of the booked accommodation and meals.
